

## Language Training Week for Staff: Practical information

### How to get to Rouen?

From airports:

From the **Paris-Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG)**:

- you can directly take the bus to Rouen. Several coaches and long-distance buses serve Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport at the Roissypole station near Terminal 3 (served by the RER at "Charles de Gaulle 1" station and at the CDGVal station "Terminal 3 - Roissypole". You can book your trip on [BlaBlaCar](#) or [Flixbus](#). The trip costs approximately 10€ depending when you book your trip. You can choose the destination "Rouen Rive Droite" to arrive next to the train station in Rouen.
- you can take RER B (towards Gare de Massy and until Châtelet) the ticket costs 10,30€ you can buy them at ticket offices and automatic sales machines in RATP stations – Châtelet: metro\* line 14 (towards Saint-Lazare) – Gare Saint-Lazare (Saint-Lazare is the station that connects Paris to Normandy, you can buy your train ticket on the French National Railway Company's [website](#)). *Note: Work is being carried out on the RER B line, be sure to check if the traffic is disrupted.*
- You can also take the Roissybus which leaves from the airport (Terminal 1 - Terminal 3 - Terminal 2AC - Terminal 2D - Terminal 2EF) and will drop you off at the Opera station in 60 minutes (ticket costs 13,70€). From this station you will walk about 5 minutes to Saint-Lazare station, where you can take the train to Rouen (Rouen Rive Droite, you can buy your train ticket on the French National Railway Company's [website](#)).

From **ORLY Airport**:

- Bus (towards Invalides) – Invalides metro station: metro\* line 13 (towards Saint-Lazare) – Gare Saint-Lazare: train towards Rouen Rive Droite, you can buy your train ticket on the French National Railway Company's [website](#))
- You can take the ORLYVAL shuttle (towards Antony) – Antony: RER B (towards Paris) to Châtelet-les-Halles- From there you can take the metro\* line 14 (Towards Mairie de Saint-Ouen and until Gare Saint-Lazare).

From **Paris-Beauvais Airport**:

- From Paris-Beauvais airport, you can take the shuttle which will drop you off at Paris Gare du Nord. The trip to Paris Gare du Nord lasts 1h15. You can buy the ticket [online](#) (one way ticket 15,90€) or at the airport (one way ticket 17€). From there, you can take the RER E line to Saint-Lazare station, you can buy your train ticket on the French National Railway Company's [website](#)). *Note: Paris-Beauvais airport is not in Paris itself, but in a city an hour away.*

## How to get to the University of Rouen Normandy?

We are located on the Mont-Saint-Aignan campus, in building B4 - Michel Serres in the heart of the campus. Many ways to get here:

- The TEOR T1 line towards Mont aux Malades - Campus stop
- The FAST F2 line towards La Vatine shopping centre - Place Colbert stop
- Bus line 8 towards Notre-Dame-de-Bondeville - Place Colbert stop.

## Hotels in Rouen

Best Western – Hôtel de Dieppe – 4 stars (from 110€ per night) Place Bernard Tissot (very close to Gare Rue Verte stop (90 m, around 2 min))

Hôtel de l'Europe – 3 stars (from 78€ per night) Rue aux Ours (in the heart of the historical centre) very close to République stop (230 m, around 4 min)

Mercure Rouen Centre Cathédrale – 4 stars (from 100€ per night) Rue Croix de Fer (behind the Cathedral)

Best Western – Hôtel Gustave Flaubert – 4 stars (from 119€ per night) Rue du Vieux Palais (in the heart of the historical centre)

Hôtel de la Cathédrale – 3 stars (from 117€ per night) Rue Saint Romain (next to the Cathedral)

## Some things good to know
